High School Varsity Championships

Singles Division

1. Everyone will bowl 5 games on Saturday moving one pair of lanes to the right after each game. Bowlers starting on lanes 39-40 will bowl their 2nd game on lanes 27-28
2. Everyone will return on Sunday and bowl 3 additional games of qualifications. Singles will bowl on lanes 1-14 on Sunday.
3. After the 8 games of qualifications, the field will be cut to the top 4 bowlers in each division.
4. Head-to-head one game matches will then occur: 4th bowls 3rd, winner advances to bowl #2; winner advances to bowl #1 etc. to crown State Champion in each division
5. All competition is scratch
6. Awards ceremony will occur at approximately noon.
7. Make sure you record your scores on your recap sheet after each game, writing legibly
8. Turn in your recap sheet Saturday after the 5th game and again Sunday after the 8th game.
9. Limit of one bowling ball on the rack per bowler.
10. Must keep walkways clear from the concourse into the bowlers' area
11. Bowlers must adhere to the uniform dress code for the tournament. NO blue jeans are permitted, nor hats, or armbands. Bowlers should be wearing their official shirts from the varsity bowling team. Coaches should be wearing their USBC Registered Volunteer Badge.
12. Scoring corrections can be made directly by the mutual agreement of the coaches. For any disputes, get Reggie Frederick, Jeff Swanson or Clayton Moore (Narrows Plaza Bowl).
