Department of Labor & Industries Are Visiting Bowling Centers Once Again

Are You Ready?



Bowling centers across the state have reported drop-in visits by inspectors from the WA State Department of Labor & Industries.

Inspections have concentrated on:

- **Center Operational Safety Manuals**
- **Pinsetter Guards**
- **Food Preparation Areas**

Centers have been issued warnings and correction recommendations with deadlines while others have been cited and assessed penalties and fines.

WSBPA, through Bob Hanson & Brenda Zimmerman with Tower Lanes in Tacoma, have prepared safety manuals available for WSBPA member centers with editions specific to AMF or Brunswick pinsetters.

The Washington Hospitality Association has additional materials available for WSBPA / WHA members.

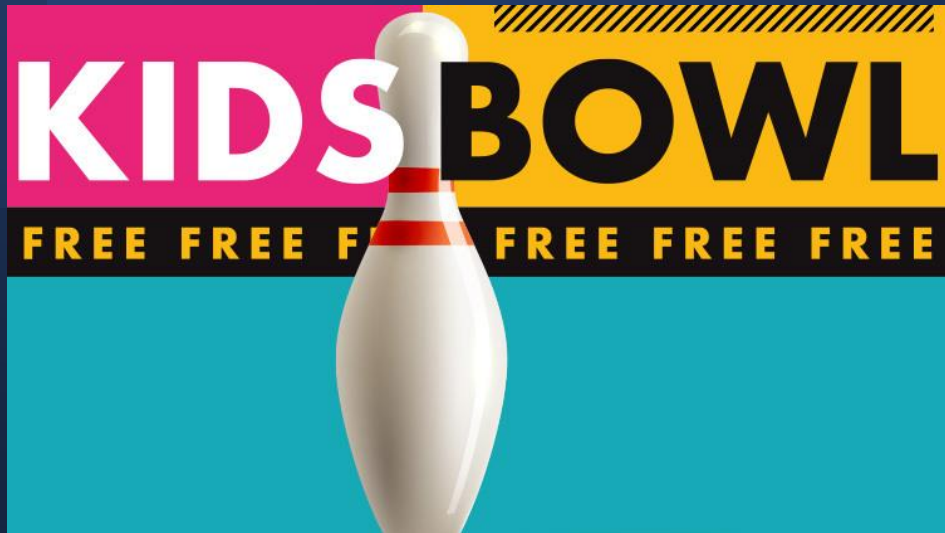

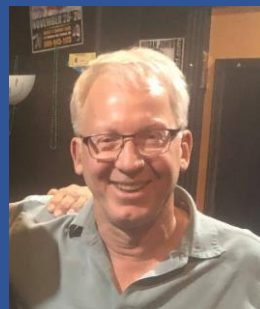
