
Pattison.

Bills being monitored include:

- SB 5578 Raise minimum wage to \$25 per hour by 2031
- SB 5070 Amend the shift of credit card fees 100% to banks and processors
- HB 1607 proposing a 10 cent bottle deposit tax on liquor, soft drink and water bottles


## **Bowling Day at the Ball Park III**
